
## **Case Study**







## Storeton Hall, The Wirral

The resin bound installation by Didsbury Garden Services at this stunning new development in the heart of the Wirral peninsula, is for a mixture of new build homes and a renovated 14<sup>th</sup> century Grade II listed building. When the developers acquired the site they gained Storeton Hall, whose first recorded tenant was in 1360 when it consisted of a great hall with an east and west wing 2 storey extension, forming a 'H' shaped building. The hall fell into disrepair and, with less than half the original building still standing, was incorporated into farm buildings. However, once restored, they became four luxury dwellings retaining as many original features as possible.

The driveways leading up to the new development were laid with LeesonBound mixed with a chocolate buff aggregate blend. The rich stone mixture complements the tones of the natural stone and wood used in the construction of the properties. The resin bound driveway gives an elegant finish to the exclusive development.
