The installation at the Oxford Centre for Islamic Studies beautifully demonstrates the decorative ability of LeesonBound PU4844. The triangular pattern laid in the service area of the grounds is striking and leads down to the immaculate gardens of the newly developed centre. The original 1985 wooden building was replaced by the new 3.25-acre site by the River Cherwell and features a mosque, minaret, auditorium, dining hall, accommodation and parking. The centre is a Recognised Independent Centre of the University of Oxford and in 1993 HRH the former The Prince of Wales became its patron and then it was granted a Royal Charter by Queen Elizabeth II in 2012.
